Flexible, specialist provision for children and young people with SEND

About our EOTAS provision

DigiTribe provides flexible online and in-person provision for children and young people who may be unable to access mainstream education because of autism, anxiety, autistic burnout, emotionally based school avoidance, health needs, SEND or other barriers to attendance.

Provision can form part of an EOTAS package, EHCP Section F provision, alternative provision, home tuition or a blended education package.

All provision can be adapted around the young person's interests, communication style, sensory needs, energy levels and ability to engage.

We use gaming and digital creativity as an alternative pathway into learning, confidence building and connection. Many young people feel safest and most able to be themselves in digital spaces, particularly when school is not viable or accessible. Our team combines youth work, play work, digital skills and trauma-informed practice to create safe, inclusive spaces online and in person.

Minimum commissioning

Online provision has a minimum booking of 1 hour.

In-person provision has a minimum booking of 2 hours.

Additional commissioning costs

Routine progress recording is included within commissioned provision. Formal reports, bespoke baseline assessment, extensive multi-agency liaison, preparation, planning or coordination may incur additional charges where required by the commissioner. Any additional costs will be agreed at placement stage.

MineMania and online community

MineMania provides a safeguarded, moderated multiplayer Minecraft environment. The server is approved by Mojang and GamerSafer following assessment. It gives young people a familiar digital space where they can connect with peers, build confidence and practise communication and social interaction with support from trained staff.

For young people aged 13+, Discord community access can provide additional opportunities for social connection, voice chat, shared interests and participation in the wider DigiTribe online community. Access and support are matched to the young person's needs and agreed provision.

For young people commissioned for two or more regular DigiTribe sessions per week, MineMania and Discord community access can be included within the agreed package where appropriate.

Accredited learning

DigiTribe is an AQA Unit Award Centre and an Arts Award Centre. AQA Unit Awards provide short, achievable units covering areas such as digital skills, creativity, gaming, life skills and SEND-friendly topics. They can recognise effort, progress and participation without requiring a young person to follow a conventional qualification pathway.



Arts Award can also be incorporated into individual programmes where appropriate, with the level and delivery plan agreed around the learner.

Example EOTAS packages

Low-demand engagement package

- Designed for a young person experiencing autistic burnout, chronic fatigue, anxiety, EBSA or prolonged absence from education.
- 1 x 60-minute 1:1 online session each week
- 1 x supported small-group social session each week
- MineMania safeguarded Minecraft community membership included
- DigiTribe 13+ Discord social community access included where appropriate
- Regular communication with parent/carer
- Routine progress recording

Accreditation and formal report fees may apply where required

A low-demand approach

For young people experiencing burnout or requiring a low-demand approach provision does not need to include conventional lessons or a full timetable. We start with relationship-building, interests, gaming,



creative activity and low-demand social contact, then gradually introduce learning, accreditation and wider outcomes when or if the young person is ready.

Sessions can be shorter, flexible or broken into manageable periods where this forms part of the agreed provision.

Our provision can be designed to support:

- Social communication and interaction
- Emotional regulation
- Confidence and self-esteem
- Peer relationships and reducing isolation
- Engagement with education
- Communication skills
- Independence
- Executive functioning
- Digital skills
- Creative development
- Accredited learning through AQA Unit Awards and Arts Award
- Preparation for adulthood
- Community participation
- Re-engagement following burnout or prolonged school absence

Commissioned provision
